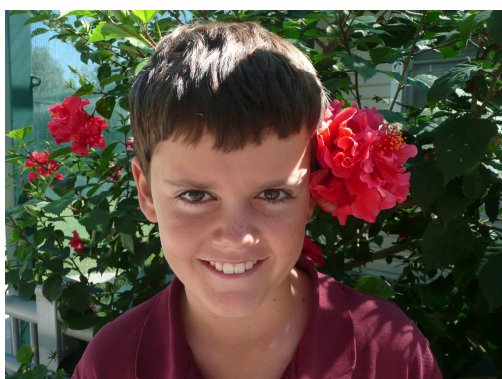
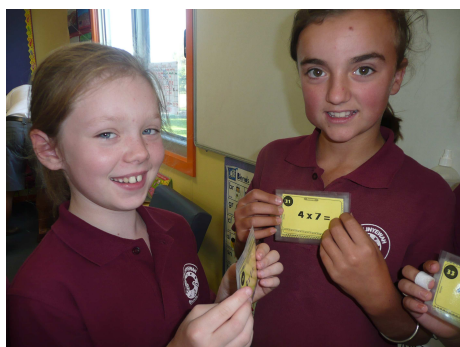
Community Notices
