Positive Behaviour for Learning

During assembly each week, we discuss different ways in which students can display our school expectations of *Responsibility, Respect and Integrity*. Over the past few weeks the focus has been on manners. Have parents noticed any of the following?

- Saying "please" and "thank you".
- Covering your mouth when you sneeze or cough.
- Asking for things instead of reaching for them.
- Knocking on doors before entering a room.
- Not interrupting when others are talking.
- Saying "Excuse me" when you need to interrupt a conversation.

- Keeping burps silent.

- Giving a genuine apology when needed.
- Asking to be excused at the end of a meal.
