COOKING WITH MRS POTTS



Amelia, Arden and Chelsea cooked up Devonshire Tea (Milo) for the students this week. Students enjoyed scones, jam & cream with a warm Milo for afternoon tea.



Scone Recipe

Ingredients: 3 cups of SR Flour, 1/2 tsp salt, 1 tbs of butter, 1 cup of Milk, 1/2 cup of water

Method: Preheat oven to 220o, line a tray with bakewell paper. Sift flour, salt into a large bowl, rub butter into flour. Make a well in centre of flour mixture, add milk and almost all the water. Mix with a knife until the mix becomes a soft dough. Add remaining water, in needed. Turn out onto a floured board and knead until smooth. Use hand to press dough out evenly to around 2cm thickness. Use a scone cutter to cut shapes. Brush tops with extra milk. Bake for approx. 15 mins or until brown.
