
#### **End of Term Assembly**

#### **Fried Rice**

#### **Ingredients**

- 2-3 family packets of pre-cooked rice or cook jasmine rice in your rice cooker as per instruction's
- 1 250g packet of bacon or 250g bacon pieces
- 2-3 eggs
- 1 capsicum
- 2-3 spring onions
- 1 medium can of corn kernels or 2 cups of frozen mixed veggies Optional soy or chilli sauce



#### Method

- \*Cook rice as per instructions.
- \*In a pan, gently heat oil, add bacon and capsicum. Fry until softened.
- \*Crack eggs in a bowl and whisk.
- \*Add other veggies and allow to cook until softened.
- \*Add eggs and allow to cook through.
- \*Add rice and combine together. Allow to warm through for a couple of minutes.
- \*Serve with soy sauce or chilli sauce as desired.
- \*Enjoy!!



#### **Ingredients**

3 cups of self-raising flour 1 tablespoon of butter Pinch of salt 1/2 cup of milk

1 cup of water (maybe not all needed)

3-4 tablespoons of jam

1 cup of sultanas / raisins or mixed fruit

2 tablespoons of melted butter

1 teaspoon of cinnamon





#### Method

- \*Rub butter into flour and add salt.
- \*Add milk and water to flour and mix in with a knife until dough is formed.
- \*Turn out onto a floured board and lightly knead. Roll out into a rectangle.
- \*Spread with jam and sprinkle dried fruit over evenly.
- \*Roll up rectangle length ways and cut into slices about 2-3cm wide.
- \*Turn each slice over so swirls are at the top.
- \*Drizzle melted butter and cinnamon over top.
- \*Bake at 180c for about 15-20 minutes.
- \*Enjoy!!
